Second phase of major project has started



April 12, 2019 - EFG Scandinavia has started the second phase of a major construction project in the North of Sweden. The experts for crane logistics solution will together with partners erect 119 wind turbines in one the world largest wind parks. Together with the generators built in Phase 1 last year, all in all 179 wind turbines with a capacity of 3.6 MW each will be producing energy for the Scandinavian market at the end of this year.
